My Father answers the prayers of those who abide in me and have my words abiding in them. They can ask for anything in my name — even moving mountains — and because they have faith instead of doubts about me, they will receive it. Why? So they can produce lasting fruit for my Father's glory. (Mathew 21:21-22; Mark 11:22-24; John 14:13-14; John 15:7 & 16)
