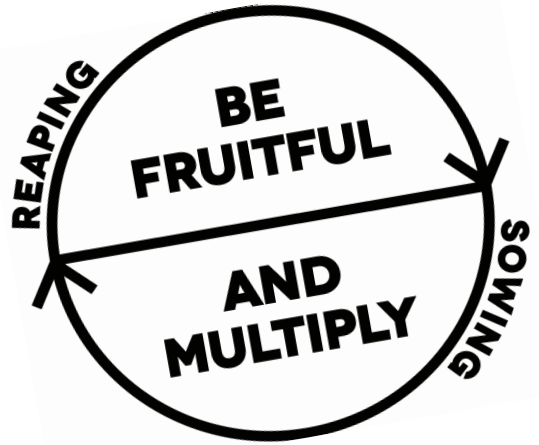


# Resurrecting Generosity

## PART FIVE



**Proverbs 11:24-25** One person gives freely, yet gains even more; another withholds unduly, but comes to poverty. A generous person will prosper; whoever refreshes others will be refreshed.

\_\_\_\_\_ **must die so generosity can live!**

**Luke 16:13** No one can serve two masters. For you will hate one and love the other; you will be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and money.

- Both rich and poor can be greedy — because greed is a matter of the \_\_\_\_\_, not the bank account.

**Colossians 3:5b** Don't be greedy, for a greedy person is an idolater, worshiping the things of this world.

**Philippians 2:3-4** Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others.

**Greed dies when these are growing:**

1. \_\_\_\_\_: when I know the true source of my provision, I don't need to continually chase "more." (Matthew 6:31-33)
2. \_\_\_\_\_: when I realize I can live in God's blessing no matter what current situation I'm facing. (1 Timothy 6:6-9)
3. \_\_\_\_\_: when my love grows for others, how can I not generously give to help meet their needs? (1 John 3:16-18)
